


New Hampshire Lags Behind in Seat Belt Use



In New Hampshire we...




- ⇒ have the **highest** number of residents killed in motor vehicle crashes not wearing seat belts
- ⇒ have the **lowest** seat belt use compared to any state in the country
- ⇒ have the **highest** occupant ejection rate in motor vehicle crashes than all other states
- ⇒ need to know that driving is a **privilege**, not a right
- ⇒ would **save more** lives on our roadways by including every age in our seat belt law

- ⇒ have the **lowest** belt use among any state in the country
- ⇒ have the **highest** number of residents killed in motor vehicle crashes not wearing seat belts
- ⇒ could still have **282** residents alive if they had been wearing a seat belt in crashes in the past 5 years
- ⇒ need to know that driving is a **privilege**, not a right
- ⇒ would **save more** lives on our roadways by including every age in our seat belt law
